- 2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF PHARMACY TO ADOPT RULES3 REGULATING PHARMACIES.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 90-85.21 reads as rewritten:

## 6 "§ 90-85.21. Pharmacy permit. permit; Board regulation of pharmacies.

7 (a) In accordance with Board regulations, each pharmacy in North Carolina shall 8 annually register with the Board on a form provided by the Board. The application shall 9 identify the pharmacist-manager of the pharmacy and all pharmacist personnel employed 10 in the pharmacy. All pharmacist-managers shall notify the Board of any change in 11 pharmacist personnel within 30 days of such change.

Each physician who dispenses prescription drugs, for a fee or other charge, 12 (b)shall annually register with the Board on the form provided by the Board, and with the 13 licensing board having jurisdiction over the physician. Such dispensing shall comply in 14 all respects with the relevant laws and regulations that apply to pharmacists governing the 15 distribution of drugs, including packaging, labeling, and record keeping. Authority and 16 responsibility for disciplining physicians who fail to comply with the provisions of this 17 18 subsection are vested in the licensing board having jurisdiction over the physician. The form provided by the Board under this subsection shall be as follows: 19
