A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDING TO REPLACE  
OUTDATED VOTING EQUIPMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The State Board of Elections is directed to identify the counties with outdated voting equipment that could result in election-day trouble and to rank those counties in terms of the severity of the problem.

**SECTION 2.** The State Board of Elections is directed to identify and pursue all available federal and other funds that become available for replacing voting equipment.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Elections for the 2002-2003 fiscal year the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to match federal and other funds that are available for replacing outdated voting equipment.

**SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
