The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 48-2-604 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(d) In determining whether a petitioner is a suitable adoptive parent under G.S.		
48-2-603(a)(8), the court shall not find the petitioner unsuitable to adopt a minor based		
solely on the age of the petitioner."		
<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 131D-10.6(1) reads as rewritten:		
"(1)	Investigate applicants for licensure to determine whether	they are in
	compliance with licensing rules adopted by the Commissi	
	provisions of this Article. In determining whether an applic	
	licensed to provide foster care in accordance with rules ado	_
	Commission, the Department shall not deny licensure base	ed solely on
	the age of the applicant."	

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
