1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
3	SERVICES TO APPLY FOR A MEDICAID WAIVER TO PROVIDE
4	PRESCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE FOR ELDERLY AND DISABLED
5	PERSONS NOT OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAID.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. The Department of Health and Human Services shall apply to
8	the Health Care Financing Administration for a Medicaid waiver to provide prescription
9	drug coverage for elderly and disabled persons who are:
10	(1) Over age 65 or disabled;
11	(2) Not eligible for Medicaid;
12	(3) Do not have coverage for prescription drugs under public or private
13	health insurance; and
14	(4) Whose family income is between one hundred twenty percent (120%)
15	and one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the federal poverty level.
16	SECTION 2. In the event that the federal Medicaid waiver applied for under
17	Section 1 of this act is approved, the Department of Health and Human Services shall
18	not implement the waiver until the General Assembly has enacted a law implementing
19	the waiver and appropriating the necessary funds therefor. Not later than October 1,
20	2001, the Department shall report to the House of Representatives Appropriations
21	Subcommittee on Health and Human Services, the Senate Appropriations Committee on
22	Human Resources, and to the Joint Legislative Health Care Oversight Committee on the
23	status of the waiver requested pursuant to Section 1 of this act.
24	SECTION 3. Nothing in this act obligates the General Assembly to
25	appropriate funds to implement this act.
26	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
