2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
3 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE CURRENT REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY
4 FOR IN-STATE TUITION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall
7 study the current requirements to qualify as a North Carolina resident for tuition
8 purposes. In particular, the Committee shall examine whether the required 12 months'
9 residency should be increased to three years, other states' requirements, and the impact
10 on students and State revenues of any proposed changes. The Committee shall report
11 any recommendations to the 2002 Regular Session of the 2001 General Assembly.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
