2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
3 STUDY THE EXERCISE OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION BY
4 MUNICIPALITIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission may study issues
7 related to the exercise of extraterritorial jurisdiction. If this study is undertaken, the
8 Commission shall examine the following issues:

9 (1) The interplay between extraterritorial jurisdiction and annexation.

10 (2) The need for the authority to exercise extraterritorial jurisdiction by
11 municipalities with a population under 500.

12 (3) Other issues related to extraterritorial jurisdiction.

13 The Commission may report to the 2002 Regular Session of the 2001 General
14 Assembly or to the 2003 General Assembly on its findings and may make any
15 legislative recommendations it considers appropriate.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
