G.S. 62A-8 reads as rewritten: "§ 62A-8. Payments from Fund. 7 8 Money from the Emergency Telephone System Fund shall be used only to (a) 9 pay for: for costs associated with receiving or processing the emergency response, including the use of law enforcement, fire, medical, rescue, or other public safety 10 11 services. 12 (1)The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone 13 equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software and 14 database provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of 15 establishing a 911 system, and 16 The rates associated with the service supplier's 911 service and other (2)17 service supplier recurring charges. The following expenses are not eligible for payment from the Fund: the lease 18 (b) 19 or purchase of real estate, cosmetic remodeling of emergency dispatch centers, hiring, 20 training, and compensating dispatchers, and the purchase of mobile communications vehicles, ambulances, fire engines, or other emergency vehicles. 21 A local government may contract with a service supplier for any term 22 23 negotiated by the service supplier and the local government and may make payments 24 from the Emergency Telephone System Fund to provide any payments required by the 25 contract." 26 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to Beaufort County only. SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to 27

28 charges billed on or after that date.
