4	Whereas, the Natural Science Center has served the City of Greensboro for
5	more than 40 years offering award-winning educational programs and exhibits; and
6	Whereas, the Center attracts 200,000 visitors annually, including 70,000
7	school children; and
8	Whereas, the Center has attracted visitors from all of North Carolina's 100
9	counties; 38 states, and eight countries; and
10	Whereas, family memberships have grown from 400 to 4,200 over the past 10
11	years; and
12	Whereas, the Center plans to build a new Animal Discovery area to replace
13	the outdated animal facility; and
14	Whereas, Animal Discovery will provide visitors with an unrivaled learning
15	environment and will serve as a regional tourist attraction; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Natural Science Center of Greensboro, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for the Animal Discovery project, a state-of-the-art, interactive, live animal exhibit that will teach visitors about

animals by allowing them to observe and imitate the animals.
