A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF THE CONSORTIUM OF THE HISTORICALLY MINORITY COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY INITIATIVE TO DETERMINE THE BEST METHODS FOR CLOSING THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP AMONG CHILDREN OF VARIOUS DEMOGRAPHIC GROUPS WHO ARE PERFORMING BELOW GRADE LEVEL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to continue to support the Historically Minority College and University initiative to close the achievement gap established in Section 8.28 of S.L. 2000-67.

**SECTION 2.** The consortium of the Historically Minority College and University initiative shall continue its work, as provided in Section 8.28(i) of S.L. 2000-67, to determine the best practices and methodologies for closing the achievement gap among children of various demographic groups who are performing below grade level. The State Board of Education and the Research Council of the Education Cabinet shall make an interim report regarding its findings and recommendations to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by March 15, 2003, and shall make a final report by March 15, 2004, to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
