**HOUSE BILL 306
RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE LAW PROVIDING FOR THE
HUNTING AND TRAPPING OF FOXES AND RACCOONS IN HYDE AND
BEAUFORT COUNTIES AND ALLOWING THE USE OF SNARES WHEN
TRAPPING FUR-BEARING ANIMALS IN THOSE COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 9 of S.L. 1997-132, as amended by S.L. 1999-86,
reads as rewritten:

"Section 9. This act becomes effective ~~October 1, 1997,~~ and expires ~~June 1, 2001.~~
October 1, 1997."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

April, 2001.
