A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SELECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY
3 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IF THE ELECTION RESULTS HAVE NOT BEEN
4 CERTIFIED BY THE DATE PROVIDED BY FEDERAL LAW.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Article 18 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended
7 by adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 163-213. Selection of Presidential Electors by General Assembly in certain**
9 **circumstances.**

10 As permitted by 3 U.S.C. § 2, whenever the election of Presidential Electors has not
11 been certified under G.S. 163-210 prior to the date for settling controversies specified
12 by 3 U.S.C. § 5, the General Assembly may select Presidential Electors."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
