A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION  
FOR SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY NEEDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of thirty-one million four hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$31,490,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-one million four hundred eighty-eight thousand five hundred forty-four dollars (\$31,488,544) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to be used as follows:

- (1) \$1,244,619 for each fiscal year to provide a technology facilitator in each low-performing school.
- (2) \$28,743,925 for each fiscal year to provide a technology facilitator in all schools where students must take the computer skills proficiency exam.
- (3) \$1,501,456 for each fiscal year to provide on-line resource subscriptions for students, teachers, and parents.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
