A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE EFFORTS FOR THE 3 PREVENTION OF HIV/AIDS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health, the sum of one million 6 dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2001- 2002 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars 7 8 (\$1,000,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for community-based intervention efforts to combat the AIDS/HIV epidemic. Funds appropriated under this section shall be 9 allocated as follows: 10

- \$300,000 each fiscal year to increase the capacity of local health 14 (2)counties where increased 15 departments in community-based organization efforts occur for the examination and treatment of persons 16 referred by the community-based organizations and to establish 17 18 alternate counseling and testing sites that are based either at the local health department or at the community-based organization; and 19
- \$400,000 each fiscal year to provide funding for the development of 20 (3) new community-based organizations to provide outreach and referral 21 services for persons at risk for HIV/AIDS. The primary focus of no 22 fewer than one-half of the community-based organizations developed 23 with funds allocated by this subdivision shall be services to racial and 24 ethnic minority populations across the State. 25
- **SECTION 2**. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001. 26
