2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE CHARLOTTE-
3 MECKLENBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM FOUR YEARS TO TWO
4 YEARS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 2(a) of Chapter 167 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as
7 rewritten:

8 "(a) In 1995 and ~~quadrennially thereafter~~, 1999, three members of the
9 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected for four-year terms by all
10 the qualified voters of Mecklenburg County. In 2003 and biennially thereafter, three
11 members of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected for two-
12 year terms by all the qualified voters of Mecklenburg County."

13 **SECTION 2.** Section 2(c) of Chapter 167 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as
14 rewritten:

15 "(c) In 1995, one member of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall
16 be elected from each district for a two-year term by all the qualified voters of the
17 district. ~~In 1997 and quadrennially thereafter~~, 1997 one member of the
18 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be elected from each district for a
19 four-year term by all the qualified voters of the district. In 2001 and biennially
20 thereafter, one member of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education shall be
21 elected from each district for a two-year term by all the qualified voters of the district."

22 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
