2 AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE
3 RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
4 REPRESENTATIVES.

5 Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain
6 appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of
7 Representatives; and

8 Whereas, the Speaker of the House of Representatives has made
9 recommendations; Now, therefore,

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11 **SECTION 1.** Betty Ann Knudsen of Wake County is appointed to the
12 Disciplinary Hearing Commission of the North Carolina State Bar to fill the remainder
13 of a term to expire June 30, 2003.

14 **SECTION 2.** Neil Ross McIntyre, Jr. of Durham County and Floyd
15 Alexander Boyer of Sampson County are appointed to the North Carolina Respiratory
16 Care Board to fill the remainder of terms to expire October 31, 2003.

17 **SECTION 3.** Daisy Millett of Yadkin County is appointed to the North
18 Carolina Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy to fill the remainder of a term to
19 expire June 30, 2003.

20 **SECTION 4.** Margaret Markey of Mecklenburg County is appointed to the
21 Clean Water Management Trust Fund Board of Trustees to fill the remainder of a term
22 to expire December 31, 2004.

23 **SECTION 5.** Sharon Elliott-Bynum of Durham County is appointed to the
24 North Carolina Center for Nursing to fill the remainder of a term to expire June 30,
25 2001, and for a full term beginning July 1, 2001, and expiring June 30, 2004.

26 **SECTION 6.** Unless otherwise provided for in this act, appointments are for
27 terms to begin when this bill becomes law.

28 **SECTION 7.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
