A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REQUIRING LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS TO COMPETITIVELY BID ALL CONTRACTS FOR FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICES UNDER THE LAWS RELATING TO FOOD SERVICE IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND AUTHORIZING THE SECRETARY OF ADMINISTRATION TO ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Part 2 of Article 17 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 115C-264.1. Contracts for food and beverage services in public schools.

- (a) The General Assembly finds that there is a need for local school administrative units to consider the competitive marketplace when entering into contracts for food and beverage services in public schools. Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-264 and G.S. 115C-522.1, to ensure that food and beverage services offered in local school administrative units are economically priced, each local school administrative unit entering into a contract for food and beverage services shall competitively bid the contract in accordance with rules adopted by the Secretary of Administration.
- (b) For purposes of this section, the term 'food and beverage services' shall include any and all foods and beverages sold anywhere in public schools. Milk shall not be defined as a beverage under this section.
- (c) The award of the contract for food and beverage services shall be made by the local school administrative unit."

SECTION 2. G.S. 143-49 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"The Secretary of Administration shall have power and authority, and it shall be his duty, subject to the provisions of this Article:
