April 5, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE 3 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR SUPPORTERS OF AUDUBON 4 NORTH CAROLINA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79(b) reads as rewritten: Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration "(b) plates: 10 Audubon North Carolina. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor (3b) vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the National Audubon Society, Inc., logo and a representation of a native 12 13 bird of the State. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by 14 this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate. (3b)(3c) Bronze Star Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the Bronze Star. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Bronze Star and the words 18 'Bronze Star'." 19 SECTION 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten: 20 Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one "(a) registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of
