17	than 100 unauthorized audio visual recording	ngs during any 180-day

19	(3) A Class 2 misdemeanor, for any other violatio	n of these sections."
20	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2002, and applies to	
21	offenses committed on or after that date.
