A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CREATE A FUND FOR PERSONS WHO WISH TO VOLUNTARILY  
PAY MORE TAXES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by  
adding a new section to read:

**"§ 143-15.3E. Tax Me More Fund.**

The Tax Me More Fund is established as an interest-bearing special account in the  
Office of State Budget and Management. Any person may elect to contribute any sum to  
the Tax Me More Fund at any time by sending the contribution to the State Treasurer. A  
person may designate the contribution to be allocated to a specific agency or program.  
At the end of each fiscal year, any monies in the Tax Me More Fund shall be allocated  
to the appropriate program or agency for the following year. Any funds that were not  
designated for a particular agency or program and any funds designated for an agency or  
program not in existence shall revert to the General Fund."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
