A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE WORLD TRADE CENTER NORTH
CAROLINA TO ENABLE THE CENTER TO DEVELOP AND SUSTAIN
INTERNATIONAL TRADE EDUCATION PROGRAMS, PROVIDE OTHER
SUPPORT FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM-SIZED BUSINESSES ACROSS THE
STATE AND, IN KEEPING WITH THE MISSION OF THE WORLD TRADE
CENTER HEADQUARTERS IN NEW YORK, PROMOTE PEACE AND

STABILITY THROUGH TRADE BETWEEN NORTH CAROLINA AND THE WORLD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the World Trade Center North Carolina, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to enable the World Trade Center North Carolina to develop and sustain international trade education programs, provide other support for small and medium-sized businesses across the State and, in keeping with the mission of the World Trade Center in New York, promote peace and stability through trade between North Carolina and the world.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 2002.
