A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO GRANT ADDITIONAL PURCHASING FLEXIBILITY TO THE
2 CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG SCHOOLS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Purchases by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local School
6 Administrative Unit of supplies, equipment, and materials valued at two thousand five
7 hundred dollars (\$2,500) or less are not subject to the provisions of G.S. 115C-522.1 or
8 Article 3 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

9 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 3 of Article 8 of
10 Chapter 115C of the General Statutes or any other provision of law, the
11 Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local School Administrative Unit may purchase textbooks on
12 the State-adopted list without using the State textbook distribution system or the
13 textbook warehouse facility operated by the State Board of Education.

14 **SECTION 3.** This act applies only to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Local
15 School Administrative Unit.

16 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2002.
