SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year for the Office of the Managed Care Ombudsman established under this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 2002.

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
