2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF A
3	STUDENT ATTENDING THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF SCIENCE
4	AND MATHEMATICS SHALL BE CREDITED TO BOTH THE STUDENT'S
5	HOME SCHOOL AND THE SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-105.35 reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 115C-105.35. Annual performance goals.
9	The School-Based Management and Accountability Program shall (i) focus on
10	student performance in the basics of reading, mathematics, and communications skills
11	in elementary and middle schools, (ii) focus on student performance in courses required
12	for graduation and on other measures required by the State Board in the high schools,
13	and (iii) hold schools accountable for the educational growth of their students. To those
14	ends, the State Board shall design and implement an accountability system that sets
15	annual performance standards for each school in the State in order to measure the
16	growth in performance of the students in each individual school. The accountability
17	system shall include methods for crediting the performance of students enrolled in the
18	North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics with both the student's home school
19	and the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics."
20	SECTION 2. Article 30 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended
21	by adding a new section to read:
22	"§ 116-239. Accountability for student academic performance to be credited to
23	student's home school and North Carolina School of Science and
24	Mathematics.
25	The Board of Trustees and the Director of the School shall work with the State
26	Board of Education to develop a method within the School-Based Management and
27	Accountability Program as set out in Part 3 of Article 8B of Chapter 115C of the
28	General Statutes that credits the performance of a student enrolled in the North Carolina
