Dropping or throwing stones or other objects at vehicles. 8 It is unlawful to drop or throw a stone or any other object at a vehicle or at the (a) 9 occupants of the vehicle. A violation of this section is a Class H felony. Notwithstanding G.S. 15A-10 (b) 1340.17, the court shall impose an active sentence on any person convicted under this 11 12 section." 13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to 14 offenses committed on or after that date.
