1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT A FELONY TO DROP OR THROW AN OBJECT AT A  
3 MOTOR VEHICLE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Article 36 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by  
6 adding a new section to read:

7 "**§ 14-281.1. Dropping or throwing stones or other objects at vehicles.**

8 (a) It is unlawful to drop or throw a stone or any other object at a vehicle or at the  
9 occupants of the vehicle.

10 (b) A violation of this section is a Class H felony. Notwithstanding G.S. 15A-  
11 1340.17, the court shall impose an active sentence on any person convicted under this  
12 section."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to  
14 offenses committed on or after that date.
