SECTION 1. G.S. 20-28(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) Driving While License Revoked. – Except as provided in subst	ection (a1) of
this section, any person whose drivers license has been revoked who drivers	es any motor
vehicle upon the highways of the State while the license is revoked is guilt	y of a Class 1
misdemeanor. Upon conviction, conviction for the first offense, the cour	rt shall notify
the Division of the conviction and whether or not the person's license sha	ıll be revoked
for an additional period of one year for the first offense, year; however, the	he court must
revoke the license if the original revocation was for a charge of driving w	<u>hile impaired.</u>
Upon subsequent convictions, the person's license shall be revoked for	an additional
period of two years for the second offense, and permanently for a third	or subsequent
offense.	
The restoree of a revoked drivers license who operates a motor veh	•
highways of the State without maintaining financial responsibility as pro	vided by law
shall be punished as for driving without a license."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law as	nd applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
