12 13 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department of Transportation the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to be used as follows: one million dollars (\$1,000,000) shall be used for anti-litter education programs and four million dollars (\$4,000,000) shall be allocated to the Department's highway maintenance budget to be used to clean up litter on the State's highways. These funds are in addition to the funds included in the Governor's recommended budget for fiscal year 2001-2002.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
