BILL SUMMARY: **UNC SYSTEM/IN-STATE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT. TO CHANGE THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT TO QUALIFY FOR IN-STATE TUITION FROM ONE YEAR TO THREE YEARS.** As title indicates. Applies to persons applying for admission for academic periods beginning on or after July 1, 2001. Does not apply to persons presently enrolled as a full-time students.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The University System has no data on how many students who are now considered in-state student would have failed to meet the residency requirement if it had been three years. These data are not collected.
