A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES TO IMPROVE FOOD SAFETY AND SECURITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to establish and operate the Food Safety and Security Task Force.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of one million eight hundred sixty-six thousand eight hundred nine dollars (\$1,866,809) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of one million three hundred seventy-seven thousand seven hundred nine dollars (\$1,377,709) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to upgrade the laboratory and the investigative and enforcement capabilities of the Department related to food safety and security.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of three hundred eighty-four thousand seven hundred forty-eight dollars (\$384,748) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year to be used as the ten percent (10%) matching requirement to obtain a grant of approximately three million eight hundred forty-seven thousand four hundred eighty-three dollars (\$3,847,483) from the United States Department of Homeland Security for funding a multiagency Food Safety and Security Project to reduce the vulnerability of North Carolina food supplies to criminal and terrorist acts.

**SECTION 4.** The Food Safety and Security Task Force shall report to the General Assembly no later than December 15, 2004, any recommendations for changes

- 1 in laws, regulations, or programs needed to enhance food safety and security in North
- 2 Carolina.
- 3 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
