AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN OPTIONAL GRADUATED TWENTY-FIVE-YEAR RETIREMENT PLAN FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 128-27 is amended by adding the following new subsections to read:

"(b21) Optional Service Retirement Allowance of Member Retiring on or After July 1, 2003, First Year. – Effective for members retiring on or after July 1, 2003, an employer may elect to adopt an optional plan for graduated 25-year retirement. Under such a plan, upon retirement from service in accordance with subsection (a) or (a1) above, on or after July 1 of the first year of the plan, a member shall receive the following service retirement allowance:

- (1) A member who is a law enforcement officer or an eligible former law enforcement officer shall receive a service retirement allowance computed as follows:
 - a. If the member's service retirement date occurs on or after his 55th birthday and completion of five years of creditable service as a law enforcement officer, or after the completion of 29 years of creditable service, the allowance shall be equal to two and ten hundredths percent (2.10%) of his average final compensation, multiplied by the number of years of his creditable service.
 - b. If the member's service retirement date occurs on or after his 50th birthday and before his 55th birthday with 15 or more years of creditable service as a law enforcement officer and

SECTION 2. G.S. 128-27(m) reads as rewritten:

"(m) Survivor's Alternate Benefit. – Upon the death of a member in service, the

- "(m) Survivor's Alternate Benefit. Upon the death of a member in service, the principal beneficiary designated to receive a return of accumulated contributions shall have the right to elect to receive in lieu thereof the reduced retirement allowance provided by Option two of subsection (g) above computed by assuming that the member had retired on the first day of the month following the date of his death, provided that all three of the following conditions apply:
 - (1) a. The member had attained such age and/or creditable service to be eligible to commence retirement with an early or service retirement allowance, or
 - b. The member had obtained 20 years of creditable service in which case the retirement allowance shall be computed in accordance with G.S. 128-27(b20)(1)b. or G.S. 128-27(b20)(2)c., notwithstanding the requirement of obtaining age 50. 50, or under the appropriate corresponding sub-subdivisions for members covered by the optional service retirement allowance provided for in G.S. 128-27(b21) through G.S. 128-27(b25).
 - (2) The member had designated as the principal beneficiary to receive a return of his accumulated contributions one and only one person who is living at the time of his death.
 - (3) The member had not instructed the Board of Trustees in writing that he did not wish the provisions of this subsection apply.

For the purpose of this benefit, a member is considered to be in service at the date of his death if his death occurs within 180 days from the last day of his actual service. The last day of actual service shall be determined as provided in subsection (l) of this section. Upon the death of a member in service, the surviving spouse may make all purchases for creditable service as provided for under this Chapter for which the member had made application in writing prior to the date of death, provided that the date of death occurred prior to or within 60 days after notification of the cost to make the purchase."

SECTION 3. The Board of Trustees of the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System shall increase the employer contribution rate to any local government that elects coverage under the optional plan for graduated 25-year retirement provided for in this act in order to reflect the additional benefits to be paid under such a plan.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
