A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR LOW-WEALTH 3 SCHOOL SYSTEMS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to 5 Local School Administrative Units the sum of seventy-seven million seven hundred 6 seventy thousand six hundred ninety-five dollars (\$77,770,695) for the 2004-2005 fiscal 7 year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding. 8

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
