1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE WAKE COUNTY TO REGULATE THE USE OF ALCOHOL AND OTHER IMPAIRING SUBSTANCES WHILE HUNTING WITH FIREARMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. A county may regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting with firearms by persons under the influence of alcohol or other impairing substances and regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting with firearms by persons who have any blood alcohol concentration as measured by an alcosensor. For the purposes of this act, an impairing substance is defined as set forth in G.S. 20-4.01.

SECTION 2. A person violating an ordinance enacted under the authority of this act is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished as provided in G.S. 14-4, "Violation of local ordinance misdemeanor."

SECTION 3. This act applies only to Wake County.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
