SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.2(a) reads as rewritten:		
"(a) Safety. – A motor vehicle is subject to a safety inspection in accordance with		
this Part if it meets all of the following requirements:		
(1)	It is subject to registration with the Division under Article	3 of this
	Chapter.	
(2)	It is not subject to inspection under 49 C.F.R. Part 396, th	e federal
	Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.	
(3)	It is not a trailer whose gross weight is less than 4,000 pour	ınds or a
	house trailer.	
<u>(4)</u>	It is fewer than 35 model years old."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
