1 AN ACT DIRECTING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
2 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE ISSUE OF LOW-WEALTH SCHOOL
3 FUNDING.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall
7 study the issue of low-wealth school funding. In the course of the study the Committee
8 shall determine the level of State funding necessary to support an adequate basic
9 education in all local school administrative units. The Committee shall report its
10 findings and recommendations to the 2005 General Assembly.

11 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General
12 Assembly the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to
13 implement the provisions of this act.

14 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
