A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT ALLOWING ROCKINGHAM COUNT

AN ACT ALLOWING ROCKINGHAM COUNTY TO REDUCE ITS MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT REQUIREMENT FOR FUNDING FROM THE AID TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES FUND.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or any rule adopted by the Division of State Library, Department of Cultural Resources, Rockingham County may reduce its maintenance of effort requirement to receive funding from the State Aid to Public Libraries Fund from one million seven hundred seventy thousand four hundred sixty-five dollars (\$1,770,465) to one million five hundred twenty thousand four hundred sixty-five dollars (\$1,520,465) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. There shall be no reduction in funding from the State Aid to

Public Libraries Fund as a result of Rockingham County's action.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
