42		house trailers under this section or G.S. 20-88, the registration and
43		license fee on house trailers shall be seven dollars (\$7.00) for the
44		license year or any portion thereof.

2		the license year or any part of the license year is two times the fee in
3		subdivision (5) for a private passenger motor vehicle of not more than
4		15 passengers.
5	(11)	Any vehicle fee determined under this section according to the weight
6		of the vehicle shall be increased by the sum of three dollars (\$3.00) to
7		arrive at the total fee.
8	(12)	Low-Speed Vehicles. – The fee for a low-speed vehicle is the same as
9		the fee for private passengers vehicles of not more than 15 passengers.
10	<u>(13)</u>	'Historic Vehicle Owner' Vehicles The annual fee for a vehicle
11		bearing a 'Historic Vehicle Owner' special registration plate as defined
12		in G.S. 20-79.4(17) shall be ten dollars (\$10.00)."
