4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the			
6	county share of the nonfederal share of Medical Assistance Program costs, excluding			
7	administrative costs, shall be as follows for counties designated as enterprise tier			
8	counties under G.S. 105-129.3:			
9	(1)	Effective July 1, 2003, through June 30, 2005, nine percent	(9%) for	
10		enterprise tier one counties.		
11	(2)	Effective July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2008, six percent	(6%) for	
12		enterprise tier one counties.		
13	(3)	Effective July 1, 2005, twelve percent (12%) for all counti	es except	
14		enterprise tier one counties.		
15	(4)	Effective July 1, 2006, nine percent (9%) for all countie	es except	
16		enterprise tier one counties.		
17	(5)	Effective July 1, 2007, six percent (6%) for all counties.		
18	(6)	Effective July 1, 2008, three percent (3%) for all counties.		
19	Effective July	1, 2009, one hundred percent (100%) of the nonfederal share of	f Medical	
20	Assistance Program costs, excluding administrative costs, shall be borne by the State.			
21	SE	CTION 2. Effective July 1, 2009, G.S. 108A-54 reads as rewritte	en:	
22	"§ 108A-54.	Authorization of Medical Assistance Program.		
23	The Department is authorized and empowered to establish a Medical Assistance			
24	Program from federal, State and county federal and State appropriations and to adopt			
25	rules and regulations under which payments are to be made in accordance with the			
26	provisions of this Part. The nonfederal share may be divided between the State and the			
27	counties, in a manner consistent with the provisions of the federal Social Security Act,			
28	except that the share required from the counties may not exceed the share required from			

the state. If a portion of the nonfederal share is required from the counties, the boards of

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- 1 county commissioners of the several counties shall levy, impose and collect the taxes
- 2 required for the special purpose of medical assistance as provided in this Part, in an
- 3 amount sufficient to cover each county's share of such assistance."
- 4 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
