AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXPAND THE SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM.

13 14 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of two million one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) for the 2003-2004 fiscal year and the sum of two million one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year to expand the school breakfast program. The State Board shall use these funds to provide breakfast without charge to all kindergarten students in the public schools.

**SECTION 2.** The State Board of Education shall develop and implement a system to evaluate whether and to what extent the expansion of the school breakfast program affects school attendance rates and the frequency of disciplinary problems.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
