A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORTH BRUNSWICK SANITARY DISTRICT TO REQUIRE MANDATORY CONNECTIONS TO ITS WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Short Title: North Brunswick Utilities.

SECTION 1. Not withstanding the provisions of G.S. 130A-55(16)a., the 6 7 North Brunswick Sanitary District may require the owner of developed property on 8 which there are situated one or more residential dwelling units or commercial 9 establishments located so as to be served by a water line or sewer collection line owned, leased as lessee or operated by the North Brunswick Sanitary District or on behalf of the 10 North Brunswick Sanitary District, to connect the owner's premises with the water or 11 sewer line and may fix charges for these connections. In the case of improved property 12 that would qualify for the issuance of a building permit for the construction of one or 13 14 more residential dwelling units or commercial establishments, and where the North Brunswick Sanitary District has installed water or sewer lines or a combination thereof 15 directly available to the property, the North Brunswick Sanitary District may require 16 payment of a periodic availability charge, not to exceed the minimum periodic service 17 charge for properties that are connected. 18

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
