AN ACT TO RECAPTURE THE GRAPE COUNCIL FUNDS FROM FISCAL YEAR 2002-2003 AND TO REDEFINE FORTIFIED WINE AND UNFORTIFIED WINE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** S.L. 2003-284 is amended by adding a new section following Section 10A.2, as enacted in Section 90 of this act, to read:

## "DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES GRAPE GROWERS FUNDS DO NOT REVERT

<u>SECTION 10A.3.(a)</u> Pursuant to G.S. 105-113.81A, funds credited to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services for the North Carolina Grape Growers Council for the 2002-2003 fiscal year shall not revert to the General Fund but shall remain available to the Council.

SECTION 10A.3.(b) This section becomes effective June 30, 2004."

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 18B-101(7) reads as rewritten:
