SECTION 1. Article 7A of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes	s is amended
by adding a new section to read:	
"§ 163-82.20A. Voter registration upon restoration of citizenship.	
The State Board of Elections, the Department of Correction, and the Ac	
Office of the Courts shall jointly develop and implement educational pro-	
procedures for persons to apply to register to vote at the time they are	
citizenship and all filings required have been completed under Chapte	
General Statutes. Those procedures shall be designed to do both of the following	wing:
(1) <u>Inform the person that the restoration of rights removes</u>	the person's
disqualification from voting but that in order to vote, the	person must
register to vote.	
(2) Provide an opportunity to that person to register to vote.	
At a minimum, the program shall include a written notice to the pe	erson whose
citizenship has been being restored, informing that person that the person	on may now
register to vote, with a voter registration form enclosed with the notice."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2006.
