2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION
3 OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE SHALL STUDY THE POLICY OF EACH OF THE
4 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
5 CAROLINA REGARDING THE ACCEPTANCE OR REFUSAL OF PRIVATE
6 GRANTS AND GIFTS TO THE INSTITUTION.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall
9 study whether the constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina have
10 policies and criteria regarding private grants and gifts to the institutions. In its study,
11 the Committee shall consider the criteria used by each constituent institution in
12 determining whether to accept or refuse a private grant or gift, the official or governing
13 body responsible for making that determination, and how the criteria are applied. The
14 Committee shall also evaluate whether improvements could be made regarding the
15 policies and criteria. The Committee shall make an interim report to the General
16 Assembly, 2006 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 2007 General
17 Assembly.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
