Short Title: Enforce Immigration Laws. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
3 OFFICERS TO ENFORCE THE FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAWS TO THE
4 EXTENT AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL LAW.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Article 20 of Chapter 15A of the General Statutes is amended
7 by adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 15A-407. State and local enforcement of federal immigration laws.**

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, State and local law enforcement
10 officers in this State may perform enforcement functions of federal immigration laws to
11 the extent allowed by federal law and subject to any training requirements and any other
12 limitations or conditions that may be imposed by federal law."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
