A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE CITY OF WASHINGTON FOR A COMMUNITY PARK.

Whereas, the construction of a community park on the site of Beebe Park in the City of Washington would provide a much needed facility for family events and for the activities of civic organizations; and

Whereas, the location of the new park is in close proximity to both a public school and the local Boys' and Girls' Club, making it an ideal recreational site that will have a positive impact on the health of area youth; and

Whereas, the City of Washington has budgeted \$25,000 towards construction of the new park, leaving the need for an additional \$100,000 in funding; and

Whereas, an appropriation to the City of Washington for the new community park is a good investment of State funds; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Washington the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to be used towards construction of a community park on the site of Beebe Park.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
