The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. If House Bill 947, 2005 Regular Session, becomes law, then		
G.S. 105-129.73(b), as created by that act, reads as rewritten:		
"(b) Development Factor. – Each year, on or before November 30, the Secretary		
of Commerce shall assign to each county in the State a development factor that is the		
sum of the following:		
(1)	The county's rank in a ranking of counties by averag unemployment from lowest to highest, for the preceding 12 m	
(2)	The county's rank in a ranking of counties by median	household
	income average wage for all insured private employers in t	he county
	from highest to lowest, for the preceding 12 months.	
(3)	The county's rank in a ranking of counties by percentage	growth in
	population from highest to lowest, for the preceding 36 mont	hs.
(4)	The county's rank in a ranking of counties by assessed prop	erty value
	per capita, from highest to lowest, for the most recent taxable	year."
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
