3 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND TWO ADDITIONAL VICTIM WITNESS LEGAL
4 ASSISTANTS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 24.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each
8 district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth
9 in the following table:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred sixty-four thousand five hundred six dollars (\$164,506) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty-five thousand one hundred eighty-four dollars (\$155,184) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish two new assistant district attorney positions in Prosecutorial District 24.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of ninety-three thousand one hundred eight-six dollars (\$93,186) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of eighty-six thousand twenty dollars

1 (\$86,020) to establish two new victim witness legal assistants in Prosecutorial District
2 24.

3 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
