A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN INCREASE IN FEES FOR CAMA PERMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 113A-119.1(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The Commission shall have the power to establish a graduated fee schedule for the processing of applications for permits, renewals of permits, modifications of permits, or transfers of permits issued pursuant to this Article. In determining the fee schedule, the Commission shall consider the administrative and personnel costs incurred by the Department for processing the applications, related compliance activities, and the complexity of the development sought to be undertaken for which a permit is required under this Article. The fee to be charged for processing an application may not exceed ~~four hundred dollars (\$400.00)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000). The total funds collected from fees authorized by the Commission pursuant to this section in any fiscal year shall not exceed thirty-three and one-third percent (33 1/3%) of the total personnel and administrative costs incurred by the Department for permit processing and compliance programs within the Division of Coastal Area Management."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to applications for permits submitted on or after that date.
