A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO WILSON COUNTY TO RETAIN A  
CONSULTANT FIRM TO CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE FEASIBILITY OF  
DEVELOPING A CIVIC CENTER IN THE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Wilson County the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to retain a consultant firm to conduct a study on the feasibility of developing a civic center in Wilson County. The study shall include the following:

- (1) Review of the operation and profitability of similar types of facilities in the country.
- (2) Estimates of the number of visitors, employment, tourist spending, products sold, and taxes collected at such a facility.
- (3) Recommendations for the type of facilities that would be best suited for the county.
- (4) Estimates of the size and cost for such a facility.
- (5) Survey of North Carolina artisans' interests in such a facility.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
