The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to Wilson		
County the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to		
retain a consultant firm to conduct a study on the feasibility of developing a civic center		
in Wilson County. The study shall include the following:		
(1)	Review of the operation and profitability of similar type	es of facilities
	in the country.	
(2)	Estimates of the number of visitors, employment, tou	rist spending,
, ,	products sold, and taxes collected at such a facility.	1 6
(3)	Recommendations for the type of facilities that would	be best suited
	for the county.	
(4)	Estimates of the size and cost for such a facility.	
(5)	Survey of North Carolina artisans' interests in such a faci	lity.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
