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## HOUSE BILL 1707

Short Title: Futures for Kids Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Yongue, Carney, Preston, Tolson (Primary Sponsors); Glazier, Johnson, and Wainwright. Referred to: Appropriations. May 12, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE FUTURES FOR KIDS 3 PROGRAM. 4 Whereas, North Carolina must continue to decrease its dropout rate by 5 motivating students to stay in school; and Whereas, modern technology linking students to career paths is an effective 6 7 means of encouraging students to stay in school; and 8 Whereas, all students, especially disadvantaged students, gain encouragement 9 to stay in school when they make the connection between their life prospects and their 10 education: and 11 Whereas, workforce development is a critical objective for North Carolina 12 whereby employers benefit from students learning in school to acquire the knowledge and skills they will need; and 13 Whereas, all citizens benefit when students find fulfilling careers where they 14 15 can contribute to society; and Whereas, the focus and strength of Futures for Kids is career exploration for 16 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> graders utilizing modern technology by providing an unassisted 17 self-guided career assessment tool, helping career counselors leverage their time and 18 19 resources so they can reach all our students, and creating an interactive system utilized 20 by students, teachers, business and parents; and Whereas, Futures for Kids implemented a pilot project involving 13,000 21 22 students, 350 educators in 26 schools and more than 200 employers statewide proving to 23 be successful; and

24 Whereas, many schools have indicated a desire to participate in Futures for 25 Kids, and their students would benefit from such additional career exploration; and

Whereas, North Carolina's business community has been highly supportive of 26 27 Futures for Kids; and

1 Whereas, Futures for Kids and the College Foundation of North Carolina 2 have embarked on a collaborative project to increase the success rate of students in our 3 educational system; Now, therefore,

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 5 SECTION 1. 6 Department of Public Instruction the sum of three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred 7 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to implement the Future for 8 9 Kids Program in all middle schools and high schools in the State. These funds shall be 10 used for equipment, staff development, and other costs of the implementation and maintenance of the program by Futures for Kids, Inc. 11 12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
